

We want to reassure you that we take the well-being of our valued clients and patrons very seriously during the COVID-19 outbreak. These protocols are in place in our venue to help prevent the spread of infectious or respiratory illness:

- Our service staff are trained in proper food handling procedures which include regular hand washing and sanitization practices based on Saskatchewan Health Authority guidelines. Disinfecting schedules are implemented in all food & beverage preparation areas.
- Over and above our existing rigorous cleaning schedule, additional cleaning has been scheduled in all washrooms. Public and washroom areas are consistently monitored for cleanliness and are supplied with the appropriate hygiene products.
- Sanitizing of general common use areas is scheduled regularly (ABM machines, elevator buttons, door handles, ramp & stairwell railings).
- Additional portable sensor-equipped hand sanitizer stations have been placed in key areas throughout our venues including all public food service lines.
- Our cleaning products are high-grade disinfectants which have been proven effective against COVID-19. Product information is available upon request.
- Administrative controls are in place to ensure proper hand washing techniques are followed by all staff.
- We have increased our communications to staff, reminding them of preventive measures such as hand washing and advising them to stay home if they are ill.
- Graphic literature outlining steps to take in order to limit the spread of COVID-19 have been created and programmed to available portable digital signage throughout the facility.

Everyone visiting our venue is encouraged to:

1. Wash hands with soap and water frequently (for at least 20 seconds).
2. Avoid handshakes and hugs.
3. Use the hand sanitizer that is provided.
4. If you feel sick, stay home or in your hotel room.
5. Follow proper respiratory cough etiquette.
6. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.

If events are cancelled or postponed, the event organizers and/or Prairieland Park will be notifying the public via the media and social media. At this time, many local events are going forward as planned. Watch the media and our social media channels to see changes and updates.
